LITURGY MATTERS

Don't Be A "Pew Potato" For Holy Week This Year



For some Catholics, getting out of bed or off the couch and going to Mass takes all the energy that they have. Some Catholics don't even do that much. But, during Holy Week, just going to Mass will not be enough. Just when you think you will be able to settle into your favorite pew, you will be asked to kneel, to stand, to leave your place, to join in a procession and even to travel. Unfortunately, many Catholics resist these beautiful rituals; they become "pew potatoes." But those who join the activities of Holy Week will find that their faith is renewed and rewarded.

On *Sunday, April 9, Passion (Palm) Sunday*, the Mass at 12:30PM will begin outdoors. Instead of going directly into the church as usual, you will be encouraged to gather in the west yard. The presider will bless our palm branches and proclaim the Gospel, and then we will all process into the church acclaiming Jesus as King. At all the other Masses that weekend, you will be asked to stand before the Entrance procession, as the presider blesses the palm branches and proclaims the Gospel from the vestibule.

On *Monday, April 10*, you will be invited to travel to our Cathedral for the Chrism Mass. At this Archdiocesan-wide Mass, our Bishop Jose Gomez, will bless and distribute to each parish, the sacramental oils that will be used throughout the year. During this liturgy, the priests will also renew their dedication to their priestly ministry.

On *April 13, Holy Thursday, at the Mass of the Lord's Supper*, after the homily you will be asked to follow Jesus' command to "love one another as I have loved you" which is powerfully done through his example of washing the feet of his disciples. After communion, the Blessed Sacrament will be carried in procession to a special place for adoration. You will be invited to kneel in homage and sing hymns of praise as the procession moves to the altar of repose.

On *Good Friday, April 14*, you will be invited to join in a procession to come forward to venerate the cross. You will also be asked to kneel in homage as the reserved Eucharist is brought into the sanctuary from the chapel.

On *April 15, at the Easter Vigil*, the procession will once again begin in the west yard. A large bonfire that shatters the darkness and signifies the resurrection of Christ will be burning. Our candidates and elect, excitedly awaiting their full initiation into the Catholic Church later in the evening, will process into the church, behind the Easter Candle, also carrying candles. You will be asked to kneel as we joyfully sing the "Litany of the Saints," that calls down the saints to be with us on this evening. You will be asked to stand to renew your baptismal vows and we will all process together as a pilgrim people to receive Jesus in both species of the Eucharist.

Finally, on *Easter Sunday, April 16*, you will experience the joy of a Sprinkling Rite and you will be asked to stand, to renew your baptismal vows, and to join in the resounding of the "Alleluia," that begins the season of joy and triumph.

So as you can see, it will be more than worth your while to get up, off the pew, and join into these various celebrations that are the high point of our entire liturgical year. 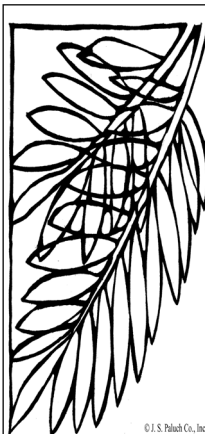
